Using the <u>Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Guidance for Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Response</u>, Montgomery County developed criteria and conditions to be met or show substantial progress in order to continue the gradual relaxing of restrictions and move towards reopening businesses and public amenities in our communities. The metrics below are best when viewed and considered holistically. They show (1) the current three-day rolling average, and (2) the number of days out of the last 14 days that saw improvement calculated using a modified CDC <u>methodology</u>. These metrics signify the various goals of a decrease in new cases/deaths/hospitalizations/patients, increasing capacity in County hospitals, and increasing testing capacity. Metrics will be updated by 2 p.m. daily.

CRL+O IMPORTANT POINTS and DATES

- All students will have the option to be on campus for an in-person, outdoor half day (8:30 am-12:00 pm) once a week
- Participation in the outdoor day is OPTIONAL. Families who would like to opt in should do so via the form presented later in the presentation.
- This mode will start the week of October 5, 2020, so the **first on-campus day will be Tuesday**Oct. 6, 2020
- This mode will continue for four weeks, until October 29, 2020
- Grace will communicate a decision about our mode for Nov. 2, 2020 onwards in an email no later than **Wednesday**, **Oct. 28, 2020**

CRL+O INSTRUCTIONAL FEATURES

- The outdoor day will provide opportunities for play, safe socializing, group cohesion, nature exploration, sports, physical activity, and more
- Children who do not come to campus for the outdoor day will have a flexible morning at home with the opportunity to do self-selected activities and (hopefully) find time to be outside
- On the outdoor day, the remote learning schedule will resume in the afternoon at 1:00 pm, with specials and closing meeting for all students
- On all other days of the week, instruction will continue via Seesaw and Zoom as it does now.
- To ensure that everyone can participate, Chapel will move to Monday at 12:30 pm. The Zoom link remains the same.

CRL+O IN-PERSON FEATURES

For Kindergarten-Grade 5:

• Two classes will be on the large playground on any given day, and they will play in separate areas of the playground to maintain distance between the groups as much as possible

For PS/Prek:

• Students will be in one group on the early childhood playground

Other:

- We will have two tents, one on the large playground and one on the early childhood playground
- Students will spend the entire morning outside, weather permitting
- Students will remain outside in light rain and cool weather
- If severe weather arises when students are already at school, we will have safe,
 socially-distanced spaces in the building available

CRL+O IN-PERSON COMMUNITY AGREEMENT
