establishing the minimum bid, bid increase amounts, and the guaranteed purchase price. Until such time as an item is sold, it is the property of the Auction Committee and can be used at its discretion.

Title to auction purchase passes upon receipt of payment by Grace-PTO. The buyer thereupon assumes full risk and responsibility.

SILENT AUCTION RULES

Bid sheets are displayed for each item. Bidder is to print his/her assigned bidder number and the amount of his/her bid on the bid sheet. All starting bids will be the minimum bid amounts noted on the sheet.
